## Biography

Qahtan Qasim Mohammed (August 5, 1982) is a distinguished professor specializing in Psychiatric and Mental Health Nursing. He currently serves as a faculty member at the College of Nursing, University of Baghdad, and holds a prominent academic position, having obtained his B.Sc. in 2004, M.Sc. in 2009, and Ph.D. in 2014 from the University of Baghdad.

Over the years, Qahtan has held various significant roles, including Head of the Psychiatric and Mental Health Nursing Department (2016-2018, 2021-2023) and Manager of the Quality Assurance & Performance Evaluation Department (2015-2016). His teaching career spans nearly two decades, during which he has taught courses in psychiatric nursing, health psychology, and human relations, contributing extensively to graduate-level education in nursing.

Qahtan has supervised numerous research theses and has participated in over 50 national and international conferences. His contributions to research focus on psychosocial issues, mental health, and stigma, making a substantial impact on both educational and healthcare fields in Iraq.

Qahtan had assigned as Head of the Committee for Developing and Formulating the Curriculum of Mental and Psychiatric Health Nursing for the National (Ministerial) Evaluative Examination. Additionally, he have taught Mental and Psychiatric Health Nursing for the evaluative examination for over three consecutive years, during which students achieved a 100% success rate under his supervision — reflecting excellence in academic performance and the effectiveness of the adopted teaching strategies.
